RECESSIONAL

PROGRAM NOTES

Graduates are listed alphabetically under the degree they are receiving, Bachelor of Fine Arts, Bachelor of Science or Bachelor of Arts. In some cases, a student may earn more than one bachelor's degree during his or her undergraduate years. The student's major(s) are listed to the right of his or her hometown, with a concentration indicated within parentheses. Directly below each name is the student's hometown. Titles of yearlong Senior Theses or Senior Creative Projects judged to merit recognition appear in italics underneath the hometown, along with the name and terminal degree of the faculty supervisor.

President's Medalists wear gold medals awarded in recognition of their status. Students graduating as members of the Honors Program wear bronze medals. Students designated in this program as graduates of the Honors Program have achieved a 3.6 cumulative grade point average, have taken at least four Honors seminars during their Denison career and have been recognized for completion of a yearlong senior research project. Student members of Mortar Board, a national honor society that recognizes college seniors for their achievements in scholarship, leadership and service, wear gold tassels on their caps.

Music for the program was coordinated by the Denison Department of Music. Today's processions are selections chosen from *The Water Music* (1717) and *Music for the Royal Fireworks* (1749) by George Frideric Handel (1685-1759). *A Fanfare for the Class of 2012* is an original composition by Assistant Professor of Music HyeKyung Lee, previously played at their induction in August 2008. Musical selections are being performed by James Van Reeth, Taylor Arend '15, Mackenzie Maynard '15, Bailey Mueller '13, Raymond Marolt '14, violins; Jolyn Tsai '13, viola; Katherine Schratz '13, Adam Coon '14, cellos; Cole Rumora '15, bass; David Nesmith, French horn; Mark Wade, Matthew McCann, trumpets; Jed Hudson, trombone. The commencement orchestra is conducted by Associate Professor of Music Andrew Carlson.

The Chapel bell ringer is Dominique Gale-McClean '13. Parents or friends taking pictures of graduates receiving diplomas are asked to use the special section designated for this purpose.

Flowers for the program are provided by Village Flower Basket. Interpretive signing is done by Reliable Interpreting Agency.

The program concludes when the platform party and faculty have recessed. The audience and graduates are asked to remain seated during the recessional. If Commencement exercises are held in the Mitchell Recreation and Athletics Center, the graduates will also recess.

ACADEMIC REGALIA

The academic costume which makes the Commencement procession so colorful is more than 800 years old, dating back to the days when students were members of the minor clergy and wore monkish gowns and hoods. Today, the hood is used only as an ornament. It is lined with the colors of the university conferring the degree: the border in which it is edged indicates the scholar's field. The colors seen in today's Denison procession and the fields they represent are: Dark Blue-Philosophy; White-Arts, Letters, the Humanities; Golden Yellow-Science; Light Blue-Education; Brown-Fine Arts; Pink-Music; Silver Gray-Oratory (Speech); Scarlet-Theology; Lemon Yellow-Library Science; Sage Green-Physical Education; Drab-Commerce, Accountancy, Business.

ACADEMIC MACE

The academic mace traces its origins to the earliest universities of medieval Europe. Today the mace connects the modern colleges and universities to the ancient heritage of higher education and represents the independence of thought cultivated by them. Denison's mace was commissioned in 2005 by President Knobel as a visible reminder of the long history of learning at the college. It was designed and crafted by Iowa folk artist Harley Refsal and is made of walnut and silver. The walnut was harvested from one of the historic trees surrounding the original Talbot Hall (1870-1967). The mace is carried at the head of the faculty procession by the Chairperson of the Faculty.

DENISON BELL

The Denison Bell was forged of nickel and silver in 1855, just as the college was moving from its original site south of Raccoon Creek to its present location. Today it is used to open and close formal ceremonies such as the Induction of each new class, Commencement and Awards Convocations.

RETIRING FACULTY

JUDITH PEAU COCHRAN

PROFESSOR EMERITA OF MODERN LANGUAGES

JUDY COCHRAN is a poet, a writer, an editor of a magnificent magazine for language and the arts, and a professor who loves teaching both language and literature.

She came to Denison in 1984 as an Assistant Professor of French, and was promoted to Associate Professor in 1990 and Professor in 1997. Cochran earned an A.B. degree *cum laude* from Smith College in 1967, M.A. (1969) and Ph.D. (1974) degrees from Duke University, specializing in French literature of the 17th and 20th centuries.

Cochran was born in Pennsylvania, raised in Youngstown, Ohio, and fell in love with the French language during her years at Smith College, home of Emily Dickinson. Two years after coming to Denison, she met one of France's finest contemporary authors, Andrée Chédid, and says it was the turning point in her life.

After reading one of Chédid's books, Cochran went to Paris to interview her and ask permission to translate it into English. She and Chédid became close friends and Cochran taught about Chédid in all her classes because of her universality. She encouraged Cochran to write her own poetry and do more than translate others' work and Cochran followed her advice.

Cochran's book of poems *Country of Lilies* was produced in 2005 in three languages, English, French and German, with the author providing the first two versions. Her other books include *Selected Poems of Andrée Chédid* in 1995 which she translated and edited, and *Women Writing in Dutch*, 1994.

Cochran created the biennial *Collage, A Magazine for Language*

& the Arts, in 2004. It is an interdisciplinary magazine designed to explore the poetry of language and the visual arts bringing all the languages of the department together. Submissions can be original poetry, short prose and bilingual translations. Cochran is the editor with a student editor appointed for each new issue.

She has been faculty adviser to the French Honor Society since 1984 and to Alpha Chi Omega beginning in 1986. Cochran has served on numerous Denison committees including the Academic Affairs Council, General Education Task Force, Honors Program Committee and Admissions and Financial Aid.

She has given presentations at conferences on languages and literature throughout the United States, Guadeloupe, the Netherlands, Canada, Morocco and France.

Cochran taught Elementary and Intermediate French, Conversation and Composition, and Stylistics and Textual Analysis. Her French Literature classes included Introduction to French Literature (Middle Ages through the 18th Century; 19th and 20th Centuries); Romanticism; Symbolism; Dada and Surrealism; and Literary Translation. Her Honors Seminars were The Figure of the Hero: The Individual and Society; Love Themes in Literature; Utopia and Anti-Utopia; Decadence in Literature and the Arts; and French Heroines of Four Centuries.

Her future plans include more writing, trips to France and Belgium every September, tending her flower and herb gardens and visiting with her son David who lives in Columbus.

CHARLES F. O'KEEFE

PROFESSOR EMERITUS OF MODERN LANGUAGES

CHARLIE O'KEEFE is a professor who discovered he loved teaching both French and French literature back in graduate school in the 1960s. His instincts must have been on the mark, since he was awarded the Denison University Charles A. Brickman Teaching Excellence Award in 2006, as well as numerous Professional Development Grants by Denison.

O'Keefe earned an A.B. *magna cum laude* from Saint Peter's College in Jersey City, N.J., in 1964 and a Ph.D. from Duke University in 1969. He was an Assistant Professor of French at the University of Pittsburgh and director of its program in Rouen, France before joining Denison's faculty in 1975.

He was the Resident Director of the Sweet Briar College Junior Year in Paris, France, in 1981-82 and 1990-91. The highly regarded study abroad program for American students wins praise for its selection of families to house its students, robust outings opportunities, and success in gaining its students' admission into Parisian institutions such as Le Louvre and the Sorbonne. He has been a member of its Advisory Board since 1991.

O'Keefe still loves the elementary languages courses and delights in teaching a first-semester class entirely in French where the students who have never spoken it before start making authentic sounding sentences and are amazed that

they are thinking in French.

His research has taken him to a wide range of fields and centuries, in books and articles in French and Francophone literature from the 17th to 21st century. He is currently working on a comparative study of the Bronze Age Greek epic poem *The Odyssey* and a 1968 postmodern French novel *La place de l'étoile* by Patrick Modiano.

He has been the Chair and Associate Chair of the Modern Languages department three times, was Director of the South African Student Summer Orientation Program in 1984 and Assistant Director of the Honors Program in fall 2001 and 2002. His Denison extracurricular involvement includes working with students as part of the Denison Service Orientation in Washington, D.C., and in QUEST, a student organization that encourages participants to think creatively about their personal, professional and civic lives.

O'Keefe plans to continue his quest as a lifelong learner and will start by learning Spanish and, who knows, maybe taking some mathematics courses at Denison. An avid photographer, he will continue that avocation and enjoy trips with his wife Jackie to visit their children David, Daniel and Emily and seven grandchildren who are dispersed across the country.

DONALD G. SCHILLING
PROFESSOR EMERITUS OF HISTORY

DON SCHILLING has devoted 41 years teaching Denison students about modern European history, particularly that of Germany, with his class on "The Holocaust in History" having an enormous impact on both him and them.

He joined Denison's history faculty in 1971, having earned a B.A. with distinction and honors in history from DePauw University (1964) and M.A. (1966) and Ph.D. (1972) degrees in history from University of Wisconsin-Madison. He held Denison's prestigious Charles and Nancy Brickman Service Chair from 2004 to 2007.

Schilling was born in Wisconsin, the son of a Methodist minister whose family descended from German immigrants and farmed in a largely German speaking area north of Milwaukee. During his college and graduate years, he studied the experience of Nazi Germany and the holocaust, and while at Denison, worked with the Holocaust Education Foundation to build networks with other scholars who were developing their expertise on this subject.

The courses he has taught over four decades include History of Modern Europe, Introduction to Modern Africa, Europe at Its Zenith 1880-1914, Rise and Fall of Nazi Germany, The Origins and History of World War II, The History of the Holocaust, and Senior Seminar, as well as various courses in the FYS program. In addition, he has worked with numerous seniors who have completed senior research and honors projects.

In 1988, he edited and wrote the introduction to *Teaching the Holocaust in a Changing World*, Volume II in the *Lessons and Legacies* series published by Northwestern University Press. His historiographical essays have appeared in *World War II in Europe, Africa and the Americas; The Holocaust and Justice; and Perspectives on the Holocaust: A Guide for Teachers and Scholars*.

In his most recent scholarship, Schilling has investigated the history of Granville in the first half of the 20th century. His three

chapters on this period appeared in *Granville Ohio: A Study in Continuity and Change*, Vol. 1, *A Purpose, A Plan, A Place*, published for the 2005 bicentennial of the Village. He has served as president or vice president of the Granville Historical Society since 2007.

He was the Director of the South African Student Summer Orientation Program that began in 1982 to prepare many of those students for graduate work in the United States during the school year. Schilling directed the program for six summers.

He was the named Dean of First-Year Students in 1997, serving in that position until 2002 as he worked with June and August Orientations for incoming students and regularly taught a First-Year Seminar in the fall term on South Africa. Students affectionately referred to him as "Dean Don of Doane" during those years.

Schilling served as chair of the history department from 1985-87, 2004-2006 and 2007-2008, associate provost of Denison from 2006-2007 and chair of the faculty in 1980-81 and 1993-94. He chaired or served on all governance councils and many campus committees and boards. He was faculty adviser for 16 years to Omicron Delta Kappa, the student leadership honorary, treating the students to one of the monthly dinner meetings at his home, complete with chili, salad and his homemade bread.

A loyal supporter of both Denison's women's and men's basketball teams, Schilling has served as women's home game announcer for the past 20 years. And he has shared his rich bass voice with Denison's Concert Choir for two decades.

Schilling is enthusiastic about moving to Williamsburg, Va., where his wife Mary is Director of Career Services at William and Mary College. When they are not visiting sons Derek and Thad and their families on the East Coast, they expect to travel the globe and explore more of the United States.

HONORARY DEGREE RECIPIENT

ELLEN GOULD CHADWICK
DOCTOR OF HUMANE LETTERS, *HONORIS CAUSA*

ELLEN GOULD CHADWICK '75 is an internationally recognized expert in the area of pediatric infectious diseases, and has focused her research and clinical career on pediatric HIV/AIDS.

She is Professor of Pediatrics at Northwestern University's Feinberg School of Medicine and Associate Chair for Education in the Department of Pediatrics. Dr. Chadwick also is the Associate Director of the Section of Pediatric, Adolescent and Maternal HIV Infection at the Children's Memorial Hospital in Chicago.

A member of the International Maternal Pediatric Adolescent AIDS Clinical Trial (IMPACT) network, she is chairperson of domestic and international protocols investigating the efficacy of new antiretroviral agents and approaches to therapy for HIV-infected infants. She has traveled to several African nations to train physicians about prevention of mother-to-child transmission of HIV. Her research on the importance of smooth-muscle tumors in pediatric HIV has resulted in two outstanding publications.

Dr. Chadwick majored in chemistry at Denison, earning a B.A. degree with honors in 1975. She was awarded an M.D. degree from the University of Virginia School of Medicine in 1979. A highly regarded clinician, educator and researcher, she has co-authored more than 40 research articles and contributed nearly

20 editorials and reviews, as well as nine chapters in medical textbooks to her field of study. In the past 13 years, she has given 26 invited presentations in the United States, Brazil, Canada and Monaco.

Dr. Chadwick is a valued volunteer in the Chicago and Wilmette public schools and the Chicago Department of Health. She was instrumental in creating the Midwest AIDS Foundation and has been its director since 1990. She also has been on the Editorial Board for *Concise Reviews of Pediatric Infectious Diseases* and an ad hoc reviewer for such scientific journals as *JAMA*, *Pediatric Infectious Diseases Journal*, *Journal of Perinatology*, *Topics in HIV Medicine* and the *Archives of Pediatrics & Adolescent Medicine*.

In 2005, Dr. Chadwick was awarded a Denison Alumni Citation at the Alumni Convocation in Swasey Chapel by Kim Cromwell '81, president of the Alumni Society. Cromwell said, "We honor Ellen Gould Chadwick for her brilliance in the research lab, her compassion as a practicing physician, and her relentless determination to conquer HIV infections in children."

She and her husband Peter are the parents of two children, Hilary and David, and live in Wilmette, Ill.
